➤ Pre-Meeting (15-Minute Maximum) Public Forum

A member of the public complained about the increase in dog fouling, despite the risk of being fined as per the Dog Control Order of 2024. District Cllr Pashley advised that a number of fines had been given in Bassetlaw. A member of the public asked about restoring a fishing peg at the River Idle, stating that the Misson Marine Club would be happy to pay. It was explained that approval would be required from the various organisations, such as Severn Trent Water, and the Environment Agency. There were also comments from the public surrounding the extermination of Moles and the Misson Parish Council Complaints procedure.

122/24 To approve the Annual Governance Statement as required by the external auditors

The Annual Governance Assertions were discussed one by one, followed by a vote on each one. In some instances, the assertions on the draft Section 1 were then changed from 'yes' to 'no'. After discussion, Cllr Walker **Proposed** the approval of Annual Governance Statement, a vote was held, 4 in favour, 2 against and 1 abstention. **Resolved** to approve the Governance Statement, and forward it to the external auditor.
